

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NANUK LODGE
100, 200, & 300 DEGREES BELOW FREEZING AWARD

This award is open to all Scouts, Venturers, Sea Scouts and Scouters.

1. Accumulate 100 degrees (Fahrenheit) below freezing (32 F) on approved camp outs in one winter season. One degree toward the total is earned for each degree below 32 F. The lowest temperature for each night of camping is counted. Wind chill factor will not figure in the temperature.

Example: On a three day campout

First night out - lowest temperature is 0 F = 32 points

Second night out- lowest temperature is -5 F = 37 points

Third night out- lowest temperature is 10 F = 22 points

TOTAL POINTS EARNED IS = 91 Points Nine additional points are needed

2. For each award, 100-200-300, one night of camping must be done in a shelter constructed on that date. It must be made of natural materials, igloo, lean-too, snow cave, etc. (No live materials may be damaged.) The other nights may be in a tent.

3. All camp outs must be in compliance with BSA Youth Protection and Guide to Safe Scouting with no less than 5 scouts in attendance. No backyard camping will be accepted.

4. One of the adults must have completed a Council approved cold weather training program EG: OKPIK, military cold weather training, or military survival training.

5. NO HEATERS inside tents will be allowed, except in warm up shelters.

6. Participation in the Fall Camp-O-Ree and/or the Council Freeze-O-Ree is required if offered by the council or district and winter camping training is included in the program activities. The event can be used to accumulate points toward the award.

Upon completion of the requirements, a signed Below Freezing Award Application and fees must be sent to the Council Service Center for approval by the Lodge. Patches are available at the Council Service Center for purchase to recognize the scouts and scouters who earned the applicable award.
